Function & Design

When planning the remodel, a more functional layout was key. The new floor plan allows for two walls of upper and lower cabinets, abundant counter space, and the addition of a craft/folding table. Relocating the washer, dryer and sink created space to add the dog wash.

New lighting brightens the room. Flooring is durable luxury vinyl in a natural limestone design. The room feels large and spacious.





Marble-look quartz countertops and champagne-bronze fixtures bring an elegant feel to the room.

Custom Details

Custom details can be found in every drawer and cabinet: a pull-out drying rack, roll-outs for dog and cat food, and bins for garbage and recycling. The craft table/gift-wrapping station doubles as a folding table.

An open space under the craft table keeps the cat's litter box out of sight. Because a small pet door is large enough for the cat to fit through, but not the dogs, the cat can finally eat her dinner in peace! She even gets her very own pull-out food and water drawer.

Removing the old refrigerator and relocating the laundry tub allowed space to add a new custom dog wash – essential when living with three big dogs. The laundry room is located just inside the walk-out basement with access to the backyard. Spring Home Maintenance Prepare Your Home for Warmer Weather!

Maintain Heating & AC

Service your furnace, AC, fireplace, boiler and water heater. Clear area around AC unit.

Replace Batteries

in smoke and carbon monoxide detectors twice a year.

Examine Brick & Foundation

Cracks may be an entry point for groundwater, insects or radon gas.

Clean Faucet Traps

Unscrew the end of the faucet, remove trap, flush out debris and replace to eliminate clogging mineral deposits.

Re-stain Fencing and reinforce or reseal as needed.

Power Wash and Reseal Deck

Prevent wood from splitting, graying or cracking.

Clean Dryer Vent

Slope Landscaping away from the

prevent seepage.

Prevent Ice Dams

Luckily, this winter's record snowfall was followed by a gradual spring thaw, preventing an epic ice dam situation for many homeowners.

Ice dams occur when the heat escaping from under your roof causes the snow to melt. The melting snow flows under the snow to the edge of the roof where it freezes. Water collects behind the dam, seeps under the shingles and makes its way into the home.

Spring is a good time to go into the attic and make sure the ceiling is air-tight so no warm, moist air can flow from the house into the attic. After sealing air leakage paths, consider increasing the ceiling/roof insulation. Next, install sufficient attic and soffit ventilation to achieve a "cold roof."

Use caution when working on your roof, especially if you'll be on a ladder. If needed, contact a professional for help.

Updated & Organized Mud Room & Laundry

The space is part of a cohesive and contemporary main floor remodel.

As part of a larger main level remodel, the laundry/mud room was fully updated with custom features to make the space more functional for an Eden Prairie family of four.

Soft gray cabinetry is a neutral backdrop for polished white quartz, glossy backsplash tile and matte black fixtures. Folding space was added above the washer and dryer.

A bench with hooks and cubbies provides easy-to-access storage and organization. A floating shelf is an unexpected detail. The finishes are reflected throughout the kitchen and main level (far right) for a cohesive look.
